ITINERARY (DAY BY DAY):

DAY 1: NAIROBI TO MASAI MARA 309.4 KM

Accommodation: Jambo Mara Safari Lodge / Similar

Guest will be picked up at their accommodation or at the airport in the morning at 9:00am and drive west to the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. You will have the opportunity to enjoy your lunch on your way and arrive in time for an evening game drive.

The Masai Mara together with Tanzania's Serengeti form Africa's most famous wildlife park, the Masai Mara National Reserve. The image of acacia trees dotting endless grass plains epitomises Africa for many, then add a Maasai warrior and some cattle to the picture and the conversation need go no further. The undeniable highlight of the Masai Mara National Reserve is undoubtedly the annual wildebeest migration traversing the vast plains of the Serengeti and the Masai Mara. Your dinner and overnight stay will be at a camp with hot showers and flush toilets.

DAY 2: MASAI MARA AREA

Accommodation: Jambo Mara Safari Lodge / Similar

Guest will wake up to a nice breakfast and then proceed on a full day of game viewing within the reserve. The landscape here is scenic savannah grassland on rolling hills. The reserve is the best park for game viewing in Kenya as it has an extensive road and



track network that allows for close range viewing and photography. Break for your picnic lunch by the hippo pool, looking out for resident hippos and crocodiles. Your dinner and overnight will be at the camp.

DAY 3: MASAI MARA AREA TO NAKURU (293.8 KM)


Accommodation: Hotel Waterbuck, Nakuru / Similar

Guest will have early breakfast and departure to lake nakuru whereby they will arrive around lunch. Nakuru is a city on the shores of western Kenya's Lake Nakuru, within a reserve that sprawls across almost 200 square kilometres. It is the capital of Nakuru County, located in the Great Rift Valley. Ten kilometres from town lies the massive Menengai Crater. Later in the afternoon guest will go on an afternoon game drive.

After breakfast this morning, enjoy a game drive. The great diversity of Serengeti wildlife is also evident here—look for buffalo, hippopotamus, elephant, giraffe, antelope, Thompson's and Grant's gazelle, lions, and in season the spectacular migration of the wildebeest.

Ikoma Tented Camp is ideally situated at the border of the world-renowned Serengeti National Park, along the path of the migrating wildebeests between Kenya and Tanzania. From Ikoma you can enter the western corridor of the park, taking in Kirawira and the Grumeti river – home to the giant wildebeest-eating crocodiles. There is no better place to enjoy one of the world's greatest wildlife spectacles. Staying at Ikoma Tented Camp gives you the unique opportunity to enjoy a night game drive or a walking safari, as the camp is located just outside the national park boundary. A great chance to see and hear some of the nocturnal animals that can't be spotted in daytime, such as the Leopard, Aardvark and the Bat-eared fox.

DAY 10: CENTRAL SERENGETI TO SERONERA (80.3 KM)

Accommodation: Serengeti Wild Camp, Seronera / Similar

This morning after breakfast you will depart to Kisumu City via Isebania border with lunch in Kisii Town. In the afternoon we visit the local tea farms and if time permits, we will see how the tea is being processed before proceeding to The Seronera region, in the



central Serengeti, is set directly on the Great Migration route, and offers excellent viewing of this incredible annual phenomenon, when countless wildebeest flood across the plains. While migratory game populations fluctuate seasonally, Seronera is still a wildlife hotspot at other times of the year, sheltering the Big Five, among many other species.

DAY 11: SERONERA TO ENTEBBE (774.6 KM)

Accommodation: Sienna Beach Hotel, Entebbe / Similar

Guest will have breakfast and go for the adventurous white water rafting on the Nile River. The rafting begins at the Source of the Nile at 09:30am with a comprehensive briefing and being fitted with the special rafting gear. The rafting is done on an 18 kilometre stretch of the Nile River and no prior experience of rafting is required. The first few rapids are of low grade (1, 2) to build the confidence of the participants before guiding them gradually into the more challenging grades. A total of eight major rapids are rafted to maximize the adrenaline rush of this adventure. You will, after the rafting adventure, be treated to a barbecue lunch and drinks before setting off for Kampala.

Guest will be picked up in Kigali and drive to Bwindi National Park. The drive to Uganda will go through Rwanda's northern town of Ruhengeri his drive will take you approx 4-5 hours. Guest will then cross over into Uganda via Cyanika or Katuna border post. Bwindi Impenetrable Forest is in southwestern Uganda, the Bwindi Impenetrable Forest is said to be Africa's oldest rainforest. It is worldrenowned for its excellent gorilla-sighting opportunities. The rugged landscape features dense jungle, cascading waterfalls, sparkling mountain streams, deep valleys and steep ridges. Upon arrival guest will go on hiking

DAY 13: BWINDI NATIONAL PARK

The national park guide will conduct the presentation that covers the basics of what to expect during the gorilla trek. The national guide will assign the gorilla trekking group during the pre-trekking briefing. Other visitors will likely join you. The gorilla trek can take from few to many hours, depending on how far the gorillas are inside the forest.

Amenities and services offered include an artisan craft shop, a backup power generator, complimentary coffee/tea, laundry services, mosquito nets, games, a restaurant, a bar and massage facilities.
