Next up, Namibia's Fish River Canyon and the world's oldest desert, the Namib. Then visit seaside Swakopmund and next, it's off to Etosha National Park for game viewing, before an overnight in Namibia's capital, Windhoek. Crossing into Botswana we experience the Kalahari Desert on a guided Bushman Walk before, the next stop is at Chobe

ITINERARY (DAY BY DAY):

DAY 1 – Cape Town AIRPORT TO CEDERBERG 179KM

Accommodation: Citrusdal Country Lodge, Cederberg / Similar

You will be picked up at the airport in Cape town Leaving the landmark Table Mountain and scenic city of Cape Town behind we make our way to the Cape Flats for a township tour of some of Cape Town's famous townships. The Cape Flats township tour gives us a chance to experience some of the vibrant local township culture. Visit community projects and meet some of the local people in South Africa's dynamic informal settlement areas. This exciting township excursion offers insight into the turbulent history and current state of the country, as well as the daily lives of these South Africans. Upon arrival guest will go on hiking before dinner.

Overnight: Citrusdal Country Lodge

Citrusdal Country Lodge is situated only 160 km north of Cape Town International Airport. It is nestled in the picturesque Olifants River Valley as the gateway to the Cedarberg Mountains. 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You will have breakfast in the morning and depart to Augrabies Falls National Park Which Located in South Africa's Northern Cape Province, the Augrabies Falls National Park encircles the mighty Augrabies Falls. The Orange River plunges 60 metres and creates this cascading splendour which leads into the 18-kilometre ravine of the Orange River Gorge. The landscape of the park is characterised by rocky outcrops jutting from scrub-dotted plains scattered with clusters of kokerboom also known as quiver trees.

DAY 3 – AUGRABIES FALLS NATIONAL PARK AREA



DAY 4 – AUGRABIES FALLS NATIONAL PARK TO NATIONAL TRANSFRONTIER PARK 369KM

Accommodation: Kgalagadi National Transfrontier Park / Similar

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You will have breakfast in the morning and depart to Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park Situated between the borders of Botswana and Namibia, Kalahari Gemsbok National Park covers nearly 10, 000 squares kilometres of orange sand dunes, solitary trees, dry riverbeds and scattered grasses. However, since no barrier separates Kalahari Gemsbok National Park from the adjacent Gemsbok National Park of Botswana, an area of 36, 000 square kilometres lies open for Africa's wildest animals to roam freely.

Overnight: Kgalagadi Lodge

Only 5km (3.1 miles) from the gate of the Kgalagadi National Transfrontier Park, The Kgalagadi Lodge offers the perfect affordable alternative to staying in the national park.

Strategically placed, the chalets make every morning a special treat. Seeing the sun rise from your front porch is a unforgettable experience, and this alone will make you want to return.

DAY 5 -AUGRABIES FALLS NATIONAL PARK TO ORANGE RIVER 354.8KM


Accommodation: Norotshama River Resort, Orange River / Similar

Riverside camping sites equipped with individual barbeques, electricity and ablution facilities are available. Norotshama Resort is located inside a private reserve, known as

Aussenkehr Nature Park. You can experience the many unique features of the Park by making enquiries at Norotshama reception.

DAY 6 – ORANGE RIVER TO FISH RIVER CANYON 589KM

Accommodation: Canyon Village Gondwana Collection Namibia/ Similar

Today you will depart to the Fish River from Orange River Carving out an epic rocky wonderland in the south of Namibia, the Fish River has created Africa's largest and the world's second largest canyon. Hot, dry and stony, the Fish River Canyon measures a whopping 160 kilometres in length, at times 27 kilometres in width and 550 metres in depth.

DAY 7 – ORANGE RIVER

Canyon Village is located 20 km east of the Fish River Canyon on the C 37.

Suitable for a striking film set, Canyon Village lies at the foot of a sweeping rock face. Exhibiting authentic canyon character, the sprawling lodge explores the story of the south in murals, traditional Nama dress and even a donkey cart to convey baggage to rooms.

DAY 8- FISH RIVER TO SOSSUSVLEI 299KM

Accommodation: Namib Desert Lodge Gondwana Collection Namibia, Sossusvlei or Similar

You will depart in the morning from Fish River to Sossusvlei area. This awe-inspiring destination is possibly Namibia's premier attraction, with its unique dunes rising to almost 400 metres-some of the highest in the world. These iconic dunes come alive in morning and evening light and draw photography enthusiasts from around the globe. Clients will get Lunch that will be served along the way where the guide will pullover by a big tree and have lunch at 12h00-13h00. After arrival guest will have leisure time before going on a Sundowner drive to Elim dune around 17h30 or 18h00.

DAY 9 – SOSSUVLEI / SESRIEM AREA

Accommodation: Namib Desert Lodge Gondwana Collection Namibia, Sossusvlei or Similar

You will wake up and have breakfast to drive to the Dunes for the Sossuvlei Excursion which includes Deadvlei, Dune 45, Hiddenvlei, and Big Daddy. The tour guide will have regular stops to let clients take pictures and have some exposure of the Dunes.





Guest will be back around lunch time and will have some leisure time for themselves at the pool while the tour guide prepares lunch for them.

At 18h00 the guide will prepare a delicious dinner for the Guest and then set up a campfire were clients will have the opportunity to talk about their experience and have some stargazing.

Guest will depart today after a fresh shower to Etosha and on arrival clients will get lunch and after Lunch, if time permits, enter Etosha for an afternoon game drive. Depending on how often you stop today, On entering the park, the first stop would be Okaukuejo where you pay your entry fee and I suggest you pop in at the local shop to purchase some drinks and snacks and most importantly, a map of Etosha which will show you all the waterholes along the way. Etosha has lions, giraffes, rhinos, zebras, springbok and elephants. This on top of many lesser and common plains herds, and abundant birds makes game viewing in Etosha.



DAY 13: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK AREA

Accommodation: Etosha Safari Camp Gondwana Collection Namibia /Similar

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This morning guest will have breakfast and go on the full day game drive inside the park, as they are on the drive the guide will have a stop at Halali around 12h00-13h00 for lunch and after lunch go on their game drive journey until afternoon.

Day 2: Full Day Etosha Game Drive

Overnight: Etosha Safari Lodge Gondwana Collection Namibia View iBrochure

Etosha Safari Lodge is located 10 km south of Andersson Gate on the C 38 (Etosha National Park).

Sip on a drink while watching the ruby sun dip into the mopane woodland. Perched on a hill with expansive views, this stylish lodge offers 65 chalets that provide a peaceful base from which to explore the animal bounty of Etosha National Park. A shuttle service operates between Windhoek and Etosha Safari Lodge and Camp (on request).

DAY 14- ETOSHA TO WINDHOEK 414KM

Accommodation: Arebbusch Travel Lodge, or similar

Guest will get early breakfast and depart to Windhoek. The guest will do a City tour in Windhoek and after that have leisure time to explore the capital city. Windhoek is often described as a city with a "continental" atmosphere due to its architecture (historical buildings dating back to the German colonial rule), cuisine, culture, dress and educational institutions.

You will have fresh shower and depart to cross the border of Namibia to Botswana Ghanzi. After arrival clients will visit the San (Bushman) Village

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Included Activity: Visit to San Village

Overnight: Ghanzi Trail Blazers

Ghanzi Trail Blazers caters for visitors who wish to have a genuine glimpse of a fast disappearing unique and ancient culture. It offers several activities to interact with the San Bushman, and to discover how they survived in the Kalahari. Ghanzi Trail Blazers is located approximately 5.6 km away from the main road, far enough away to capture the real African bushveldt.

DAY 18: GHANZI TO MAUN 285.1KM

Accommodation: Island Safari Lodge, Campsite, Maun / Similar

Guests will grab early Breakfast and then take a short drive to Island Safari Lodge situated in Maun. After checking in and freshening up In the Afternoon the clients will depart for a Mokoro Excursion (for 2 hours) After this activity clients will get back and the lodge and get ready for Dinner.

DAY 19: MAUN AREA

Accommodation: Island Safari Lodge, Maun / Similar

Accommodating 12 guests in 6 en-suite meru tents Sango Safari Camp is designed in the style of the classic tented safari camp of days gone by. With its open-air bucket showers, hand crafted furnishings and classic styling Sango Safari Camp aims to rekindle the atmosphere of the luxury mobile safari camp, successfully blending the rustic with the luxurious.

With the Khwai River forming a natural border between the world famous Moremi Game Reserve and Khwai Concession, animals can travel freely through this vast unfenced wilderness. Situated on the river overlooking the Moremi and with access to both these magnificent wildlife areas, Sango Safari Camp is focused on delivering an exceptional wildlife experience to our guests. The camp's location allows guests to take advantage of a host of wildlife activities which include open vehicle game drives both in the Moremi and in the Khwai concession area, night drives and mokoro trips.

DAY 21: KHWAI COMMUNITY AREA TO CHOBE RIVER FRONT 265KM

Accommodation: Chobe Game Lodge, Chobe River Front / Similar

you will have a game drive throughout Chobe and its beautiful landscape across the challenging Magwikwe Sand point, which was the shoreline of the ancient inland sea, visit the Makgadikgadi Lake. Its deep sand, so in the wet season, it becomes impassable. After arrival clients will check in and prepare for dinner.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner



DAY 22: CHOBE RIVER FRONT

You will wake up for breakfast and then have a full day game drive in the Chobe National Park. Expected animals to see are lion, wild dog, cheetah, leopard, giraffe, bushbuck, blue wildebeest, and huge numbers of hippo.

You will return around 17h00 after a long day of game viewing and will have a goodnight sleep after long day.

Accommodation: Victoria Falls Rest Camp, Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe


