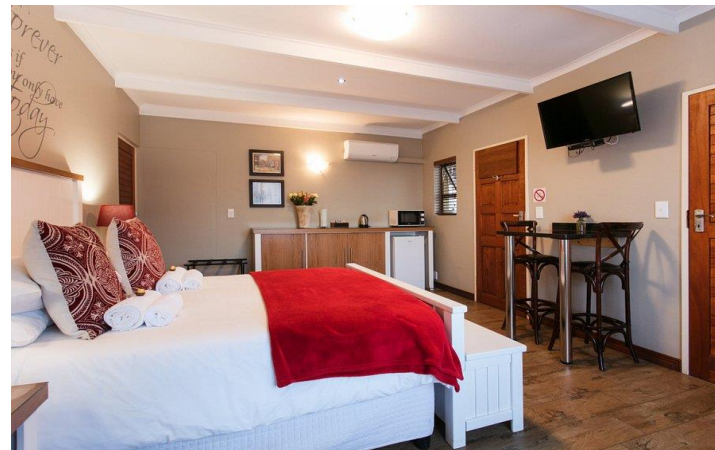

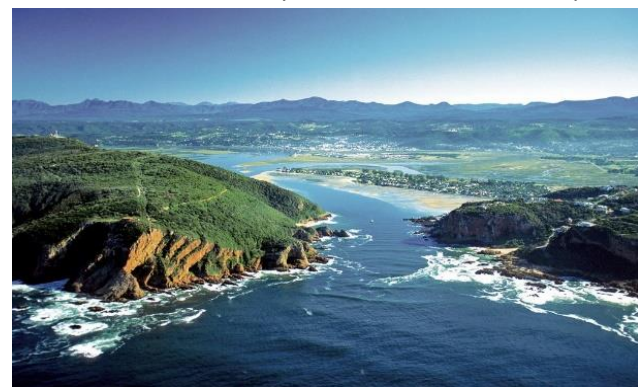


## DAY 8-DAY 9: KNYSNA HEIGHTS VILLA, KNYSNA
