ITINERARY (DAY BY DAY):

DAY 1: CAPE TOWN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO CAPE GRACE, CAPE TOWN

Accommodation: Waterfront Village, Cape Town / Similar

This morning around 09:00 guest will be picked up at the airport and transferred to the accommodation. Cape town is resting at the confluence of the Indian and Atlantic oceans, sandwiched between the slopes of the iconic Table Mountain and the glistening sapphire waters of Table Bay, the exceptionally scenic city of Cape Town is in a class of its own. Some cities boast rich culture, vibrant nightlife, a cosmopolitan atmosphere and extraordinary architecture, while others boast breath-taking landscapes and extraordinary natural wonders. DAY 2: CAPE TOWN

Accommodation: Waterfront Village, Cape Town / Similar

Guest will have a nice breakfast and go on a breath-taking full day Private Peninsula & Penguins tour.

Be collected from your accommodation in Cape Town at around 9:00 AM with a qualified guide. If this is your first time in Cape Town, you will be taken on a 30-minute city orientation tour before heading out and travel along the Atlantic seaboard, driving between the mountains and the ocean, and pass through Bantry Bay, Clifton, Camps Bay, Llandudno, and Chapman's Peak. Guest will stop in Hout Bay, where you will have the option of taking a boat to Seal Island. For lunch, you can enjoy the fresh seafood at harbor eateries. Alternatively, a light meal will be available further on at Noordhoek village, along with the best coffee this side of the Cape at Roast Village. Next, set off for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and the Cape Point lighthouse, a popular stop for photographs. Continue to Simon's Town to see the monument of the Great Dane dog who made his own history in the South African Navy. Visit Boulder's Beach and see the penguin colony. Guest will be back afternoon before dinner. There are variety places for guest to choose to go have their lunch and dinner.

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DAY 3-4: CAPE TOWN

DAY 5,6: CAPE TOWN TO CETERBERG FROM KRUGER PARK VIA THE PANORAMA ROUTE TO JOHANNESBURG AND FLIGHT TO CAPE TOWN

Accommodation: Letaba Main Camp, Central Kruger / Similar

Guest will have breakfast, refresh themselves and depart to Central Cedrberg Set in the heart of South Africa's largest and best-known game reserve, Central Kruger is home to abundant lion, hyena, cheetah, leopard, buffalo, wildebeest, elephants, zebra and birds of prey. Flowing through the region is Olifants River, known to be a bathing and drinking site for hippos, elephants and other mammals. Visitors can explore the area with guided game drives, bush walks, bird walks, and night drives. Upon arrival guest will go hiking with the guide.

Recommended Activities: Hiking Overnight: Letaba Main Camp

The popular Letaba Camp is set in the heart of the Kruger on a wide bend of the Letaba River and well-positioned for viewing the elephant and buffalo that come to drink there. Incorporated into the camp is an elephant museum, which provides fascinating insights into the Magnificent Seven and the current status of elephants in the park. Letaba is a green oasis in the surrounding mopane veld.








DAY 7: CETERBERG TO MANYELETI PRIVATE GAME RESERVE 132.3KM

Accommodation: Pungwe Bush Camp, Manyeleti Private Game Reserve / Similar

This morning guest will have early breakfast and drive to Manyeleti Private Game Reserve which shares its borders with Kruger National Park, Timbavati Game Reserve and Sabi Sands Game Reserve, forming part of a huge area of land in which wildlife roams free. It is managed by the Mnisi people, who have lived on this land for many generations. In Shangaan, the language of the most dominant tribe in the area, Manyeleti means 'Place of Stars' and in the evenings, when the sun's light is replaced by that of the moon and countless bright stars, one can understand why. Upon arrival guest will check in and go on a game drive

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DAY 8: MANYELETI PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Accommodation: Pungwe Bush Camp, Manyeleti Private Game Reserve / Similar

Guest will have early breakfast and go on a full day game drive to experience close encounters in a natural unfenced environment with the Big 5: elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion and leopard, but also with wild dog, cheetah, zebra, giraffe and a variety of indigenous antelope. It is a paradise for the wildlife enthusiast with close to 150 mammal species, over 380 species of indigenous trees, as well as over 500 bird species. Mountains, bush plains and tropical forests are all part of the landscape.

Overnight: Pungwe Bush Camp

Pungwe is a small intimate authentic safari camp which brings back the essence of a true safari experience. Our comfortable en-suite meru-style tents are reminiscent of days when safaris were all about the sights, sounds and smells of the bush. Our camp is about the bush, the animals, the unique experiences and the subsequent regaling of these by the iconic fireside. Only under canvas will you not only hear, but feel the roar of the lion, the throaty cough of a leopard and the Fiery Necked Nightjar celebrating the night. Situated in the southern part of the 22 000 hectare Big 5 Manyeleti Reserve, Pungwe shares unfenced boundaries with two world renowned reserves, the Sabi Sand Reserve to the south and the Kruger National Park to the east, allowing for free movement of wildlife between the three reserves.







DAY 9: MANYELETI PRIVATE GAME RESERVE TO CHOBE RIVER FRONT FLIGHT

Clients will have a breakfast and take a domestic flight from Nelspruit Airport near Kruger to Chobe River Camp is located 4km from the Ngoma border post between Botswana and Namibia. 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DAY 11: CHOBE TO VICTORIA FALLS 162 KM

Guest will have a nice breakfast and drive to Victoria Falls upon arrival around 16:00 guest will go on an African Queen Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi.
