



5-DAYS BEST SERENGETI, NGORONGORO TARANGIRE &
MANYARA SAFARI (CAMPING)

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TOUR DETAILS:

This tour provides the chance to explore the northern circuit parks with landscape and beautiful scenery too, the tarangire with its savannah, baobab trees, and seasonal swamps is home to huge elephant herds, the Serengeti, The largest park in Tanzania with a diversity of landscapes and habitats, such as grassy plains, swamps, lakes, and mountains. Here the biggest wildebeest and zebra migration takes place and depending on season you will have the opportunity to witness thousands of animals.

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

1. We will discover Lake Manyara National Park which features the largest concentration of baboons. The alkaline waters of Lake Manyara are encrusted with rosy feathered flamingos.
2. Tarangire is famous for having one of the largest elephant populations in Africa.
3. The Serengeti conjures up images of exploration, dramatic landscapes and exhilarating wildlife.
4. The Ngorongoro Crater has been denoted as 'Africa's garden of Eden'.

ITINERARY (DAY BY DAY):

DAY 1 - ARUSHA TO LAKE MANYARA 2.5 TO 3 HOURS (114 KM)

Pick up at 8:30 AM from your hotel in Arusha and depart for Lake Manyara National Park with a picnic lunch for a full day game drive. As you enter the national park, lush forests of Acacia and Mahogany trees begin to set the mood for what is waiting ahead. The game drive will go on till evening with a small break for picnic lunch. During the game drive watch out for buffaloes, giraffes, impalas, baboons and the blue monkeys. Another spectacle of Lake Manyara National park is the tree climbing lions, however spotting them is a game of luck. In the right season, you can see the shoreline turning pink with millions of flamingos flocking there. Post the game drive, you will head back to your camp/lodge where a delicious dinner awaits you.

Overnight: Panorama Safari Camp

Distance: 114 KM

Time : 2.5 to 3 hours



DAY 2: LAKE MANYARA TO CENTRAL SERENGETI 4 TO 4.5 HOURS (192 KM)

After breakfast we head towards the Serengeti National Park, via the beautiful high lying farmland of Karatu and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Leaving the highlands behind, we descend into the heart of wild Africa - the Serengeti National Park - with its endless plains, rolling into the distance as far as the eye can see. We head to the central park area, known as the Seronera area, one of the richest wildlife habitats in the park, featuring the Seronera River, which provides a valuable water source to this area and therefore attracts wildlife well representative of most of the Serengeti's species. We arrive in time for lunch and enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Serengeti National Park.

Overnight: Seronera Campsite

Distance: 192 KM

Time : 4 to 4.5



DAY 3: SERENGETI TO NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA 1 HR 32 MIN (62.2 KM)

After breakfast, you will have a morning game drive in Serengeti National Park. Later depart for Ngorongoro Conservation Area with picnic lunch. Ngorongoro Crater is the largest collapsed volcanic crater in the world and fourteen kilometers of isolated natural beauty. Ngorongoro Crater is surrounded by a ring of extinct volcanoes and the floor, dotted with watering holes, shelters some 30,000 animals. The eventful day comes to an end with a heavy dinner and a good night's rest in your accommodation.

Overnight: Simba Campsite A

Distance: 62.2 KM



DAY 4: NGORONGORO CRATER

After an early breakfast, descend to the crater floor for game drive (5 hours). You can expect to see lions, elephants, Zebras, Hippos, Flamingos, Jackals, Rhinos Antelopes and many birds. The birds seen here include eagle, vulture, and flamingos in the Crater Lake, stork, bats, giant vulture, sacred ibis, kori bustard, blacksmith plover, long necked heron and the cattle eagle. Post the picnic lunch at the beautiful Hippo pool, you will begin a steep ascend to the top exit of the crater. Freshly made delicious dinner is kept ready for you at your accommodation. All these days of the safari, will have you quite tired and a good rest is essential.

Overnight: Simba Campsite B



DAY 5: NGORONGORO CRATER TO ARUSHA (DISTANCE: 190.6 KM APPROXIMATELY)

After an early breakfast, we will have time for a short game drive and then ascend the crater and exit Ngorongoro Conservation Area towards Arusha. We expect to be back in Arusha around 5pm although we are flexible in case there is a flight to catch or another situation.

Distance: 190.6 KM

Time : 3 hr 56 min
