


5 Days Swakopmund and Cape Cross Tour (Lodging) Swakopmund - Cape Cross 5 Days / 4 Nights

ITINERARY

Day 1-2 Windhoek to Swakopmund : 361.43km

Accommodation: Hotel Pension A La Mer, Swakopmund or similar

Guest will departs to Swakopmund early morning at around 09:00 am from Windhoek to the coastal side of Namibia. It's about 3 hours' drive to Swakopmund. Once you have arrived, they will get lunch and afterward go to the activity center for Quadbiking and Sandboarding which will last for 2-3 hours. You will have dinner at a Restaurant.


Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Activities Included:

Day 1: 3-Hour Quad Biking and Sand-Boarding

Day 2: Sandwich Harbour and Walvisbay Lagoon

Optional Excluded activities: Living Dunes Experience from Swakopmund ; Scenic Desert Tour, Sky diving.



Overnight: Hotel Pension A La Mer

Ideally situated in the heart of the old town in Swakopmund, Hotel Pension A La Mer is a short walk away from the sandy shores of the beach and the historic jetty.

The hotel boasts 46 en-suite bdrooms, all of which are charming in design and range from a standard room to an executive luxury room. All rooms feature breathtaking views and are equipt with Wi-Fi, cable TV, an electric kettle. Guests can look forward to starting their day with a scrumptious breakfast.

Activities surrounding the hotel include boat and harbour tours, scenic flights, township tours, fishing and hot hair balloon rides.



Day 3-4 – Swakopmund to Cape Cross 122.73km

Accommodation: Cape Cross Lodge, or Similar

Guest will depart in the morning from Swakopmund and depart to Cape Cross which is best known for its extraordinary breeding colony of Cape fur seals and has been made a reserve. With the abundance of fish swimming in the cold Benguela current, the seals have plenty to snack on, and they also enjoy lying and playing out in the sun.

Overnight: Cape Cross Lodge

Situated on the Skeleton Coast in Namibia, Cape Cross Lodge overlooks the Atlantic Ocean and presents a unique and serene stop for travellers. Nearby, rocky outcrops provide a perfect playground for a large colony of Cape Fur Seals. There is a museum situated within the lodge.

The lodge features a mix of Cape Dutch and West Coast fishing village architecture and offers a selection of eighteen sea view standard suites, two sea view semi-suites, and a single self-catering unit. During their stay, guests can enjoy a la carte dining at the on-site restaurant.

Terms and Conditions

1. A 30 % non-refundable deposit of the full amount due is required to confirm any reservation and is to be done by the agent or client by fax or e-mail.

2. The Company must receive the balance of the contract price no later than 60 Days prior to departure.

3. If the Company does not receive the full contract price 45 days before the departure date, the Company may cancel the reservation and retain whatever deposit or other funds it has already received from the client or his agent.

4. The payment can be done via Bank Transfer or Paypal into Safari World Tours

5. Differences due to currency fluctuations will not be accepted.

6. Namibian Dollar is not an international trading currency and will encounter larger handling fees due to conversions

7. Any cancellation of a confirmed booking must be done in writing (email) to the Company.

8. If the booking is cancelled, the following fees apply relative to the amount of notice given:

- \square 60 Days before tour 80% refundable of amount paid
- \square 45 days before: 50% of invoiced amount refunded
- □ 15 or less days: No refund

9. If a booking is changed to an earlier date than originally reserved, the Company will endeavour to change it. But if changed to a further date there will be a charge of 5% on invoice value.
