Introduction

Our 3 Days Tour is a Hiking Trail Tour which you will be camping at the Waterberg Resort Campsite at the northern side of Namibia, here you will experience the fascinating geological site, 200 million-year-old dinosaur footprints, and petrified dunes. During this 3 days clients will be hiking throughout the landscapes and trekking rhinos by fit. This tour needs clients to be physically fit and be able to walk approximately 4km-6km a day.

Day 1: Waterberg Resort Campsite, Waterberg Plateau National Park (279.6km)

You will be met by our Safari Guide and then depart for the Waterberg Plateau Park. The Waterberg area offers breath-taking views and an adventure you won't forget. In the afternoon you will reach the Waterberg Resort Campsite where you will check-in you will have an afternoon game drive for 2-3 hours before returning to the campsite for your overnight stay.

Included Activity: catching a glimpse of the rare and endangered sable and roan antelope. (Game Drive)

Overnight: Waterberg Resort Campsite or Similar

Waterberg Plateau National Park

Situated in north central Namibia and named for the springs that emanate from its foothills, the Waterberg Plateau National Park is a fascinating geological site featuring

compressed sandstone crags, 200 million-year-old dinosaur footprints, and petrified sand dunes. The area's natural water sources make it far more fertile than its environs, and the park is blessed with a plethora of plant and animal species, including leopards, rhinoceros, vultures, cheetahs, bush babies, ferns and fig trees. Visitors can enjoy a wide selection of activities including: learning about the local Herero culture on an informative village tour, tracking rhino on a guided safari, exploring the Waterberg's 50-kilometre-long and 16-kilometre-wide sandstone plateau, dubbed 'table mountain', and catching a glimpse of the rare and endangered sable and roan antelope.

Overnight: Waterberg Resort Campsite

Waterberg Resort Campsite is situated at the entrance of the valley on the southeastern slope of Waterberg Plateau National Park. There are 45 campsites available which feature modern conveniences. Guests can enjoy breakfast, lunch and dinner at the onsite restaurant or unwind with a refreshing drink at the bar. The campsite also features an outdoor swimming pool, Wi-Fi access and a television in the lobby. Guests can enjoy game drives, hikes and cultural tours during their stay.

Day 2: Waterberg Resort Campsite, Waterberg Plateau National Park

After an early breakfast you will have a morning plateau hike for 2-3 hours your hiking guide climbs the plateau with you (approx. 150 m above the plains). He explains plants and animals in the park to you and gives you an insight into the daily life and culture of the Herero people living in this area. Terrific view of the valley or of the plains of the Kalahari and in the afternoon nature trail whereby you explore the valley of the nature reserve "Botanical Garden". You will dine under the stars and enjoy the romance of the fire until the wildlife calls of the nights fade away and you fall asleep.

Day 3: Waterberg Resort Campsite, Waterberg Plateau National Park

The morning calls of the birds will wake you up at sunrise. You will break camp and have breakfast you will head out, on foot, into the reserve. Despite the extreme conditions of the region, it is still rich with a variety of wildlife, especially around the watering holes (3-4 hours). The goal and aim today is to track the Rhinos by Foot doing it like the Bushmen. Guided by your tracker you will explore our nature reserve at the foot of the Waterberg and detect game such as oryx or red hartebeest, kudu or giraffe you might even come face to face with rhino the trail leads you along the mountain ridges of our base camp that have already been set out for you. After your walk you will enjoy a well-deserved hot shower in the bush camp upon arrival you will check-out and start your drive back to Namibia's capital city arriving in the midday. This is where your safari will end.

1. A 30 % non-refundable deposit of the full amount due is required to confirm any reservation and is to be done by the agent or client by fax or e-mail.
2. The Company must receive the balance of the contract price no later than 60 Days prior to departure.
3. If the Company does not receive the full contract price 45 days before the departure date, the Company may cancel the reservation and retain whatever deposit or other funds it has already received from the client or his agent.
4. The payment can be done via Bank Transfer or Paypal into Enrico's Tours and Safaris
5. Differences due to currency fluctuations will not be accepted.
6. Namibian Dollar is not an international trading currency and will encounter larger handling fees due to conversions
7. Any cancellation of a confirmed booking must be done in writing (email) to the Company.
8. If the booking is cancelled, the following fees apply relative to the amount of notice given:
 - 60 Days before tour 80% refundable of amount paid
 - 45 days before: 50% of invoiced amount refunded
 - 15 or less days: No refund
9. If a booking is changed to an earlier date than originally reserved, the Company will endeavour to change it. But if changed to a further date there will be a charge of 5% on invoice value.
