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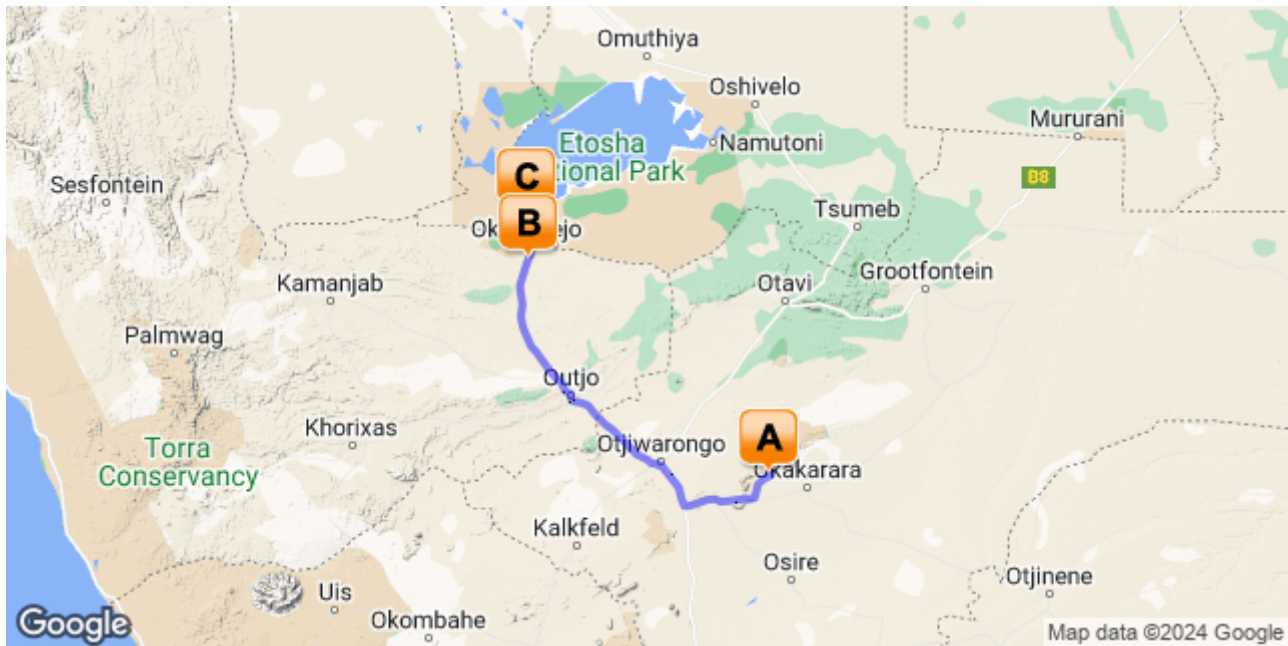

## **Day 1: Waterberg Resort Campsite, Waterberg Plateau National Park (279.9km)**

You will be met by our Safari Guide and then depart for the Waterberg Plateau Park. The Waterberg area offers breath-taking views and an adventure you won't forget. In the afternoon you will reach the Waterberg Resort Campsite where you will check-in you will have an afternoon game drive for 2-3 hours before returning to the campsite for your overnight stay.

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### **Waterberg Plateau National Park**

Situated in north central Namibia and named for the springs that emanate from its foothills, the Waterberg Plateau National Park is a fascinating geological site featuring compressed sandstone crags, 200 million-year-old dinosaur footprints, and petrified sand dunes. The area's natural water sources make it far more fertile than its environs, and the park is blessed with a plethora of plant and animal species, including leopards, rhinoceros, vultures, cheetahs, bush babies, ferns and fig trees. Visitors can enjoy a wide selection of activities including: learning about the local Herero culture on an informative village tour, tracking rhino on a guided safari, exploring the Waterberg's 50-kilometre-long and 16-kilometre-wide sandstone plateau, dubbed 'table mountain', and catching a glimpse of the rare and endangered sable and roan antelope.

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### **Overnight: Waterberg Resort Campsite**

Waterberg Resort Campsite is situated at the entrance of the valley on the southeastern slope of Waterberg Plateau National Park. There are 45 campsites available which feature modern conveniences. Guests can enjoy breakfast, lunch and dinner at the onsite restaurant or unwind with a refreshing drink at the bar. The campsite also features an outdoor swimming pool, Wi-Fi access and a television in the lobby. Guests can enjoy game drives, hikes and cultural tours during their stay.

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## **Day 2: Waterberg Resort Campsite, Waterberg Plateau National Park**

After an early breakfast you will have a morning plateau hike for 2-3 hours your hiking guide climbs the plateau with you (approx. 150 m above the plains). He explains plants and animals in the park to you and gives you an insight into the daily life and culture of the Herero people living in this area. Terrific view of the valley or of the plains of the Kalahari and in the afternoon nature trail whereby you explore the valley of the nature reserve "Botanical Garden". You will dine under the stars and enjoy the romance of the fire until the wildlife calls of the nights fade away and you fall asleep.

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## **Day 3: Etosha Safari Campsite Gondwana Collection Namibia, Etosha South (244.5km)**

You will depart from Windhoek to Etosha National Park and stay 3 nights. The park's main characteristic is a salt pan so large it can be seen from space. Yet there

is abundant wildlife that congregates around the waterholes, giving you almost guaranteed game sightings. At the same time, Etosha National Park is one of the most accessible game reserves in Namibia and Southern Africa, the concentration of big games around the waterholes makes game viewing incredibly rewarding. You might not even have to leave your rest camp to see lions, elephants, rhino and any number of antelope and zebra quenching their thirst

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### Etosha South

Located just south of the boundary of Etosha National Park in northwestern Namibia, Etosha South makes up the southern region of this wild paradise. The area is comprised of a collection of world class private game reserves. The national park can be accessed via the southern entrance at Andersson's Gate. Visitors can catch a glimpse of a variety of wildlife including: lion, giraffe, elephant, white and black rhino, and a multitude of plains game. Popular activities include: enjoying an open 4x4 safari with an expert guide, half day or full day drives with the option of a picnic lunch with wine on the full day game drive.

Set up under Mopane trees with loving care, this campsite offers guests many shady spots covered with lawn. Apart from showers, toilets and sink units there are several power points all over the site as well as mobile grills.

Camping guests are welcome to use the swimming pool of neighbouring Etosha Safari Camp (a two minutes' walk). And those who want to treat themselves to dinner after an exciting day are most welcome at the camp's Okambashu restaurant. The Oshebeena bar next-door, decorated in typical township style, is just the place for a little get-together in the midst of African joie de vivre. Only 9 km away from Andersson gate, the camping site is the ideal basis for safari excursions into Etosha National Park.

Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk and camping facilities.
